# It's easy to get the care you need

At Kaiser Permanente, our mission is to take care of you. As a member of our HMO plan:

- Save time: Visit our medical offices to see your doctor, and get lab work and X-rays done – all in the same place (in most locations, you can even pick up a prescription).<sup>2</sup>
- Avoid extra questions and paperwork: Your care team members are connected to each other, and to you, through your electronic health record. So they'll know important things about your health, like when you're due for a screening and what medications you're taking.<sup>2</sup>
- Connect with care wherever you are: No time for an appointment? No problem. Connect with your care team through email, online chat, phone, or even video visits.<sup>2,3</sup>

#### Get great care and coverage – together

- Choose a physician: Choose to receive care from more than 1,200 Kaiser Permanente doctors, one of the largest multispecialty groups in Colorado, or an affiliated plan doctor. If your needs change, you can make a change, anytime. Visit kp.org/locations to search for Kaiser Permanente physicians and affiliated plan providers near you.<sup>4</sup>
- Use a variety of services: Our HMO plan includes primary care, select specialty care, urgent care at designated offices, as well as pharmacy, lab, radiology, vision, and audiology services, where offered.
- Stay healthy: Prevention plays a vital role in health care. To catch problems early, we offer preventive screenings and routine appointments. To help you stay healthy, we offer classes and resources – many of them online.

#### How it works

Routine care: This is generally covered with a fixed copayment and includes doctor visits, inpatient hospitalization, urgent care, and much more. Preventive visits, such as physicals, adult screenings, well-child care, and certain immunizations, are available as well.

**Specialized care**: If you'd like to see a specialist, you can schedule a consultation with virtually any Kaiser Permanente specialist, or an affiliated plan specialist, no referral needed, with a few exceptions.<sup>4</sup>

Once you reach your out-of-pocket maximum, Kaiser Permanente will pay 100 percent for most covered services for the rest of the year.<sup>5</sup>



#### **Prescriptions**

You can always fill or refill your prescriptions at any Kaiser Permanente pharmacy. Depending on the type of medication, you may also be able to fill your formulary prescriptions at an affiliated plan pharmacy, or have them delivered to your doorstep using mail order pharmacy or our convenient same-day/next-day delivery service.<sup>6</sup>

New to Kaiser Permanente? Don't worry. Our clinical pharmacists will work with you and your doctor to understand our formulary and transfer your prescriptions. Same-day deliveries must be within a 15-mile radius of a participating pharmacy and a delivery fee applies. Some restrictions may apply.

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
